<b>Brief Summary</b>	<p>The training course is devoted to the study of psychodiagnostics - the most popular section of psychology. The second section gives us an idea of the specific methods of studying individual psychological characteristics of a person, methods of processing and interpretation of the results, and will let us to select psychological tools according to the needs of practice.
